Response:

Based on the suggestions by the members of the BOS, the proposals are presented for approval to Academic Council (AC).

As the three constituent colleges (M.S. Ramaiah Medical College, M.S. Ramaiah College of Physiotherapy and M.S. Ramaiah Institute of Nursing Education and Research) have come under the ambit of MSRUAS from the academic year 2022-2023 students have not yet completed their first academic year (annual) at MSRUAS, the feedback is yet to be taken into account. However, wherever the programmes are in Semester scheme, feedback has been taken after completion of 1st semester and report have been submitted. Several new programmes have been introduced in the last five years, data have been collected and submitted accordingly.
