**HEI Claim for Metric 5.1.1**

MSRUAS encourages and supports deserving students to get financial assistance under various Government schemes. The Directorate of Student Affairs (DSA), MSRUAS makes efforts to create widespread awareness among the stakeholders about various scholarship schemes available from various 'scholarship providing institutions/agencies. There are designated persons in the campus/campuses who provide the necessary assistance to students to seek such aid. The MSRUAS Nodal Officer liaise with the Social Welfare Department, Department of Minorities' Welfare and other institutions to get the benefit of such schemes for stakeholders. Regarding the HEI Scholarships, there is a well laid down Policy and SOP, as per which various benefits like Scholarships, Free ships, Fee waiver/Fee discount are provided to the students. All information regarding scholarship opportunities is posted on the MSRUAS website.

The students of the institution have benefitted from scholarships awarded by the various Government Departments such as Backward Classes Development Corporation, Social Welfare Department and further, the students of the institution have received scholarship benefits from

agencies/institutions, viz; Jindal Scholarship

The university offers fee waivers to students who belong to economically weaker sections as per the MSRUAS Scholarship/Freeship Policy. Dr. M.S. Ramaiah Trust helps needy and meritorious students and provides scholarships to students from economically weaker sections to pursue higher education. In the Academic Year 2020-21, MSRUAS instituted Covid Freeships for those affected by the pandemic. In the Academic Year 2022-2023, to commemorate the birth centenary of the Hon'ble Founder Chairman of the Ramaiah institutions, MSRUAS awarded meritorious students with the Centenary Scholarships.

In the last five years, 17933 students benefitted from institutional free-ships, fee waivers and scholarships
