**HEI Claim for Metric 5.1.3**

The Directorate of Transferable Skills and Leadership Development, MSRUIAS focuses on personal development of the students. The Directorate of Transferable Skills and Leadership Development as well as the 13 faculties of MSRUIAS has been organizing specific Soft Skill training sessions for students in order to prepare them for employment. The soft skills training sessions are conducted in batches of 25- 30 students and are highly effective in enhancing their confidence levels, interpersonal communication, teamwork and virtual communication, thus increasing employability of the students.

The HEI presents, details of Soft Skills Training and the list of students are appended as supporting document for the last five years. Circulars, timetables, reports and attendances of each of the programs under each initiative are provided as evidence. The reports include the details of title, date, duration of the program and number of students benefitted as well as attendance of students. Due to the guidelines during the pandemic, the programs were conducted online. in Academic Years 2019-20 and 2020-21.

These activities have helped the students to excel, create, adapt and maintain their capacity over the last five years. Soft skill training, life skill enhancement schemes such as yoga, self-defense, first aid, physical fitness, health and hygiene, self-employment and entrepreneurial skills and sessions to enhance awareness in technology are a few of the initiatives taken.

Ramaiah Institute of Nursing Education and Research, Ramaiah Physiotherapy College and Ramaiah Medical College have sessions for the students to learn spoken Kannada so that they would be able to interact with patients who know only the local language. In order to help students from other states in India to settle down in Karnataka, session in Basic Kannada was conducted in both campuses. Spoken Hindi classes were conducted.

MSRUAS focuses on organizing awareness of trends in technology training sessions for students in order to prepare them for employment. Keeping up with technology trends is essential in today's world. Technology is constantly evolving, staying up-to-date with the latest trends can help students stay competitive in the job market, give them access to new features and capabilities and help them save time and money in the long run. Students interested in improving their employability received training from corporate trainers and other faculties. The faculties introduce their students to the latest technology which is relevant to their field. Specific software has been installed, workshops are conducted and students are allowed to get hands on experience.
